



About Central Valley Rails to Trails Foundation

The Central Valley Rails to Trails Foundation (CVRTF) was founded ten years ago by local residents who saw great potential in a local rail corridor. Recognizing the need for safe routes to ride bikes, horses and take a walk, those visionaries reached out to the owners of the Central California Traction Rail Corridor (CCT), primarily Union Pacific Railroad, to see if they had any further use for a 27 mile segment between Sacramento and Lodi.

Over the years, they successfully built a base of support for the proposed trail, including public officials, local governments, recreation agencies and leaders in the business and residential communities. Partnering with the Trust for Public Land, all systems were go; and then the economic crises hit. The railroad decided to mothball some of their fleet of trains, hundreds of which are now parked along the CCT. At the same time, the High Speed Rail Authority took a renewed interest in the CCT for their Sacramento to Stockton segment.

Being a stubborn lot, the Board of CVRTF has stood strongly in support of the trail as the best use of the CCT corridor. The focus now is on keeping local property owners informed of plans under consideration for the Corridor, and continuing to work toward a successful trail project.



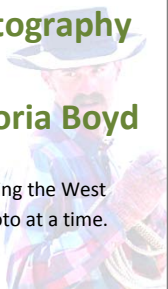

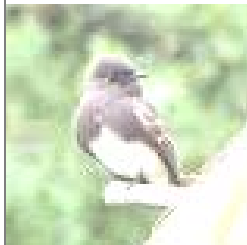
